Bishop Joseph Anthony DE PALMA (September 4, 1913 - February 3, 2005)

Biographical profile



Bishop Joseph Antony De Palma. Fifth Superior General (July 17, 1959 - June 6, 1967). He was born on September 4, 1913, in Walton (New York), USA. He made his first profession on October 1, 1939 and was ordained on May 20, 1944. He was elected fifth Superior General of our Congregation on July 15, 1959. Appointed Bishop of De Aar (South Africa) on April 13, 1967 by Paul VI and ordained on July 19, 1967. He died in Saint Petersburg (Florida) USA on February 3, 2005.

The fact that it is through love alone that we shall be united with God, does not minimize the importance and necessity of humility. For in order to arrive at this union, we need the foundation to love, and that is humility. The experts on the spiritual life, especially the great Saints, tell us that humility is the solid rock upon which we must build our spiritual life. We need humility, a great deal of it, the humility which empties our souls of pride, of disorderly love of self and exaggerated appraisal of personal worth, in order to put us in our proper place in relation to God and our fellow men. Dear Confreres, it should be most evident to us that the virtue of humility was, as it were, the seal upon the whole life of Christ. Now certainly the servant must also wear the livery of his master. If humility is difficult for me I have the great example of Christ before me. Moreover, I can and should pray to Jesus in all earnestness for greater success in the practice of this virtue: "Jesus, meek and humble of heart, make my heart like unto thine".
